Here to support individuals, communities and employers achieve their ambitions and recover as quickly as possible from the pandemic.



As a key anchor institution in the Solent, South Hampshire and Central South region we recognise our responsibility to both lead and proactively collaborate to champion and support Covid recovery and growth. Our campuses are readily accessible, and Eastleigh College Online launched in April 2021 extends our reach far beyond our geographic footprint. We continue to prioritise funding for our region, as such we have the infrastructure and resources to positively and influentially contribute to regional recovery. Our 2021/22 Eastleigh College Covid Recovery Commitments build on our successful Covid-19 Bounce Back Pledge that was <u>launched in July 2020</u>.

Collaboration is at the core of our approach to Covid recovery. Since July 2020 the College has worked with over 900 employers with over 35 employers formally supporting the College's pledge. We have worked with regional education and training providers to develop clear, up-to-date and unbiased information on where and how employers can access funding and financial incentives to upskill their workforce and succession plan. In addition the College is a core partner of the proposed Solent Institute of Technology that has the ambition to extend higher level education and training opportunities across the region. It is our ambition that our Covid recovery commitments will see our employer network continue to grow, whilst also further strengthening our existing employer partnerships.

We will continue to train the future workforce of the region, as well as training the current workforce, our support also extends to those who lose their jobs, or who need to retrain or upskill. Our commitments 'guarantee' places for learners on a wide range of our provision, by making these 'guarantees' we are seeking to provide reassurance and certainty for individuals and communities that the College is here for them to pursue their ambitions and goals.

During the pandemic we have also invested in our facilities for learners. Some of this investment has been on our unseen areas, but has also included the development of our new Learner Hub. This new facility is located directly from our canteen area and has been designed to the highest standard to provide learners with a professional and aspirational environment whether using the space independently or with peers. The new facility has also enabled us to centrally locate every service that any of our learners may need during their time with us – truly a "one stop shop". In addition, we continue to invest in our digital infrastructure and resources so as learners can seamlessly study whether at campus or elsewhere.
